Clinton River CDF



Project Features

- Clinton River CDF is an upland facility in Mount Clemens, MI. The CDF is located at river mile 3.0, adjacent to the Selfridge Air National Guard Base.
- Navigation Project Served: Clinton River
- The CDF was constructed in 1989 under authority from Section 123 and has less than five years of capacity remaining.
- Clinton River CDF has an area of 30 acres, has a total capacity of 370,000 cubic yards, and receives about 4,700 cubic yards annually.
- The CDF is owned by the Michigan Department of Natural Resources and operated by the US Army Corps of Engineers.

Beneficial Use Information

- The material in this site has a fine grain size.
- Direct transportation access to the CDF is available via road and water.
