## Duluth-Superior Harbor - Erie Pier CDF



### Project Features

- Duluth-Superior Harbor - Erie Pier CDF is an in-lake facility attached to land located in Duluth, MN. The CDF is situated next to a former ore dock on the St. Louis River.
- Navigation Project Served: Duluth-Superior Harbor
- The CDF was constructed in 1979 under authority from Section 123 and was expanded in 1989, 1990, and 1999. Erie Pier CDF has less than five years of capacity remaining.
- Erie Pier CDF has an area of 82 acres, has a total capacity of 2,493,000 cubic yards, and receives about 25,500 cubic yards annually.
- The CDF is owned by the Seaway Port Authority of Duluth and the City of Duluth and is operated by the US Army Corps of Engineers.

### Beneficial Use Information

- The material in this site has a mixed grain size.
- Direct transportation access to the CDF is available via road and water in addition to possible transportation access by rail within one mile of the site.
