Indiana Harbor CDF



Project Features

- Indiana Harbor CDF is an upland facility in East Chicago, IN.
- Navigation Projects Served: Indiana Harbor and Canal
- The CDF currently under construction under authority from the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1910, 1930, 1935, 1937 and 1960, WRDA 1986 and 1996, and Emergency Supplemental Appropriations Act dated 12 May 2005. The construction of the CDF is expected to be completed in 2009 and will provide 30 years of capacity.
- Indiana Harbor CDF will have an area of 96 acres, will have a total capacity of 4,800,000 cubic yards, and will receive about 200,000 cubic yards annually.
- The CDF is owned and operated by the US Army Corps of Engineers.

Beneficial Use Information

- The material in this site has a mixed grain size.
- Direct transportation access to the CDF is available via road and water in addition to possible transportation access by rail within one mile of the site.
