## Manitowoc Harbor CDF



### Project Features

- Manitowoc Harbor CDF is an in-lake facility attached to land in Manitowoc, WI. The CDF extends north from the north breakwater at Manitowoc Harbor and borders the Manitowoc small boat harbor on the east.
- Navigation Project Served: Manitowoc Harbor
- The CDF was constructed in 1975 under authority from Section 123 and has less than five years of capacity remaining.
- Manitowoc Harbor CDF has an area of 24 acres, has a total capacity of 800,000 cubic yards, and receives about 11,900 cubic yards annually.
- The CDF is owned by the City of Manitowoc and is operated by the US Army Corps of Engineers.

### Beneficial Use Information

- The material in this site has a mixed grain size.
- Direct transportation access to the CDF is available via water in addition to possible transportation access by rail within one mile of the site.
