## Calumet Harbor – Chicago Area CDF



### **Project Features**

- Calumet Harbor CDF is an in-lake facility attached to land in Chicago, IL. The CDF is located in Calumet Harbor adjacent to the port's Iroquois Landing Facility.
- Navigation Projects Served: Chicago Harbor, Chicago River, Calumet River and Harbor
- The CDF was constructed in 1984 under authority from Section 123 and has less than five years of capacity remaining.
- Calumet Harbor CDF has an area of 42 acres, has a total capacity of 1,300,000 cubic yards, and receives about 50,000 cubic yards annually.
- The CDF is co-owned by the Illinois International Port Authority and the US Army Corps of Engineers. Calumet Harbor CDF is operated by the US Army Corps of Engineers.

### **Beneficial Use Information**

- The material in this site has a mixed grain size.
- Direct transportation access to the CDF is available via road and water in addition to possible transportation access by rail within one mile of the site.
