



## Erie Harbor CDF



### **Project Features**

- Erie Harbor CDF is an in-lake facility attached to land in Erie, PA. The CDF is located on the south side of a bay formed by Presque Isle Peninsula.
- Navigation Project Served: Erie Harbor
- The CDF was constructed in 1979 under authority from Section 123 and has more than ten years of capacity remaining.
- Erie Harbor CDF has an area of 23 acres and a total capacity of 420,000 cubic yards. Dredging quantities have historically amounted to approximately 100,000 cubic yards per dredging event, which occurs infrequently. However, only a limited amount of dredged material has been placed into the CDF over the years, with most of the dredged material placed in open lake.
- Future use of the CDF may be very limited since open lake placement will be the likely placement option used, pending sampling and analysis.
- The CDF is owned by the Erie-Western Pennsylvania Port Authority (EWPPA) and is operated by the US Army Corps of Engineers.

### **Beneficial Use Information**

- The material in this site has a mixed grain size.
- Direct transportation access to the CDF is available via road and water in addition to possible transportation access by rail within one mile of the site.

### **Post Closure Use**

- The post closure use of Erie Harbor CDF is intended for industrial development.
- Approximately 25% of the CDF, closest to land, has been turned over to the EWPPA for recreational camping use.
