Kewaunee Harbor CDF



Project Features

- Kewaunee Harbor CDF is an in-lake facility attached to land in Kewaunee, WI. The CDF is located on north of the Kewaunee River on Lake Michigan adjacent to the shore and breakwater.
- Navigation Project Served: Kewaunee Harbor
- The CDF was constructed in 1982 under authority from Section 123 and has less than five years of capacity remaining.
- Kewaunee Harbor CDF has an area of 28 acres, has a total capacity of 500,000 cubic yards, and receives about 14,000 cubic yards annually.
- The CDF is owned by the City of Kewaunee and is operated by the US Army Corps of Engineers.

Beneficial Use Information

- The material in this site has a mixed grain size.
- Direct transportation access to the CDF is available via road and water in addition to possible transportation access by rail within one mile of the site.
