



Little River Harbor, NY

Harbor Features

- Located along the Niagara River in the City of Niagara Falls, Niagara County, New York.
- Authorization: River & Harbor Act of 1954.
- Shallow draft recreational harbor.
- Project consists of an entrance channel approximately 1,200 feet long and 50 to 200 feet wide.
- Authorized depth is 8 feet in the entrance channel.
- Major stakeholders consist mainly of the recreational boating community.

Project Needs

- Currently, there are no critical maintenance needs.
- Semi-annual maintenance needs include project condition surveys and maintenance dredging.
- Maintenance dredging is required approximately every 10-15 years. On average, approximately 10,000 cubic yards (CY) of sediment is dredged per event. The harbor was last dredged in 1988.



Consequences of Not Maintaining the Project

- Potential safety issues for recreational boating community.
- Negative economic impacts, locally and regionally.

Transportation Importance

- Provides safe access between Little River and Niagara River.
