



Silver Bay, MN

Harbor Features

- Located on the north shore of Lake Superior, 55 miles northeast of Duluth, MN.
- Authorization: Section 2 of the River and Harbors Act of 2 March 1945 and Water Resources Development Act (WRDA) of 2007
- Shallow draft recreational harbor
- Approximately 2,730 feet of rubble mound break water structure with 660 feet of concrete walkway on breakwater, encompassing 12 acres.
- Major stakeholders include Minnesota DNR, City of Silver Bay, Marina Concessionaire and recreational boating interests.

Project Requirements

- Currently, there are no critical maintenance requirements.

Consequences of Not Maintaining the Project

- Potential safety issues for recreational boating community
- Potential functional loss of Critical Harbor of Refuge
- Negative economic impacts locally

- Critical Harbor of Refuge
- This project supports recreational navigation interests.
