

I-RAP-St. Louis River-40th Av West, MN

Project Location: The project was located in the St. Louis River estuary just upstream of Duluth Harbor.

Project Description: The St. Louis River and Duluth Harbor are located near Duluth, Minnesota. The Minnesota Pollution Control Agency requested that the Corps provide engineering and technical assistance in the design of aquatic habitat that would assist in removing Beneficial Use Impairments (BUI)s from this Area of Concern (AOC). This project is authorized under Section 401(a) of the Water Resources Development Act of 1990, as amended – Remedial Action Plans (RAP).

Non-Federal Partner: Minnosota Pollution Control Agency (MPCA)

Project Benefits: Restored benthic, fish and aquatic vegetation habitat.

Project Status: The Design and Plans and specs have been completed and handed over to the Sponsor for implementation in June 2017.
