Project Location: The project location is a former navigation channel in the Milwaukee Estuary, within Milwaukee, WI.

Project Description: Through the Remedial Action Plan (RAP) Program, the Non-Federal Sponsor has asked for assistance with Plans and Specifications to design a near shore wetland habitat in a former navigation channel in Milwaukee Estuary Area of Concern (AOC). USACE will provide the design to cap the contaminated sediment base with an impermeable cap and a create a wetland habitat environment. Project execution will be by Non-Federal Sponsor. This project is authorized under RAP 401 - Provide technical, planning, and engineering assistance to States and local governments in the development and implementation of remedial action plans for areas of concern in the Great Lakes identified under the Great Lakes Water Quality Agreement of 1978..

Non-federal Partner: Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD)

Project Benefits: Restores 5 acres of nearshore habitat suitable for Northern Pike Spawning.

Project Status: FY16 funds are being used to complete the design by September 2016. Construction will be 100% funded and executed by the Non-Federal Sponsor.
