Project Description: The proposed project involves the restoration of the Kinnickinnic River channel to a more natural stream condition with meanders, shelter areas, and riffle pool complexes. Rocky and deeper water areas would be created in order to provide refuge for fish to feed and rest. The upstream project limit is located at 9th Street and extends approximately 1,400 lineal feet downstream to 6th Street. This phase of work will result in the restoration of the Kinnickinnic River from Lake Michigan upstream to near Jackson Lagoon, once other outstanding projects are completed. This project is authorized under The project is authorized under Section 206, Water Resources Development Act of 1996, as amended - Aquatic Ecosystem Restoration..
