



**PROJECT:** Detroit River Navigation Improvement, MI (Chickenbone Reef)

**DESCRIPTION:** The project area is in the lower Detroit River, in Wayne County, Southeast Michigan, offshore of downtown Detroit, Michigan. The proposed project consists of removal of a rock reef to provide for improved navigational access for cruise ships and other vessels to the City of Detroit waterfront.
