



PROJECT: Rouge River, MI (Navigation Improvement)

DESCRIPTION: The Rouge River is located in Southeast Michigan and is a primary commercial Federal Navigation Channel in the region. The existing project has an authorized depth of 25 feet below Low Water Datum (LWD) on the lower end of the Federal channel from the confluence with the Detroit River upstream to the Jefferson Avenue crossing. The authorized depth from this point upstream to the turning basin is 21 feet below LWD. To ensure the long-term viability of this important transportation corridor, the deepening of the upper reach of the Federal navigation channel is proposed.
