


**PROJECT FACT SHEET**

**PROJECT:** Harbor of Refuge, Two Harbors, MN

**DESCRIPTION:** In 1991, the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) and the North Shore Management Board selected a string of 9 harbors of refuge for small boats navigating the north shore of Lake Superior. Two Harbors, located 28 miles northeast of Duluth, Minnesota, would be a part of this system.

**STAGE:** PDA phase.

**STATUS:** The Corps is completing design of the project. A draft Project Cooperation Agreement (PCA) has been reviewed by the State. The State of Minnesota is negotiating access to the property so that required archeological and environmental surveys can be completed. Delays in getting access to the property have caused considerable delay in project execution

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
