


PROJECT FACT SHEET

PROJECT: Flint River and Swartz Creek, Flint, Michigan

DESCRIPTION: Project area is Flint River and a portion of the Swartz Creek Branch and the adjacent flood plain located between the Grand Traverse Avenue Bridge (Riverbank Park) and the Third Avenue Bridge (Mott Park) in Flint, Genesee County, Michigan. Scope of work is to restore the Flint River ecosystem and nurture a sustainable environment by removing the 1966 USACE flood control project. The flood control project consisted of concrete berms along the river banks which eliminated the natural ecosystem, making it devoid of flora and fauna.
