PROJECT: Baileys Harbor, Frog Town Road

DESCRIPTION: Frog Town Road runs along the top of a limestone bluff along the shore of Lake Michigan, in the Town of Baileys Harbor, Door County, Wisconsin. Approximately 2,000 feet of the road has experienced severe erosion over the past few years and is now in danger of collapse. The road is owned and maintained by the Township of Baileys Harbor. In addition, the road serves as access for approximately 20 homes as well as providing water views for the general public.
