


PROJECT FACT SHEET

PROJECT: Gibraltar, MI

DESCRIPTION: The City of Gibraltar is located in Wayne County, in southeastern Michigan, across from the southern end of Grosse Ile, on the Detroit River. The proposed project involves the construction of shoreline erosion protection for a roadway and a bridge abutment along the Gibraltar Canals.

CONGRESSIONAL INTEREST: Conyers (D) MI-14; Dingell (D) MI-15.

STAGE: PDA (Planning and Design Analysis)

STATUS: As a result of delays, cost estimates and economic evaluations are being revised. A 100% plans and specs was projected for April 2004. Minimal FY04 funding exists for advancement of this project. Upon resolution of budgets and priorities, a revised schedule will be prepared. FY05 funds could be used to finish P&S, sign a PCA, and initiate construction.

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
