


PROJECT FACT SHEET (20 FEB 04)

PROJECT: Northshore Drive Emergency Streambank Protection

DESCRIPTION: The purpose of this project is to provide approximately 1,700 feet of emergency riverbank protection along the north bank of the St. Joseph River in South Bend, IN. This section of riverbank is steep and is severely eroded adjacent to North Shore Drive between Parkovash Avenue and Lafayette Boulevard. Several utilities that run along North Shore Drive are also in jeopardy. The project will protect North Shore Drive and the adjacent utilities between Parkovash Avenue and Lafayette Boulevard.

STAGE: PDA (Planning and Design Analysis)

STATUS: Design of this project was initially completed in 2000 and packaged with two other reaches on the St. Joseph River, but languished because of environmental issues on this reach. To date, the IDNR has not issued the required "Construction in a Floodway" permit for the Northshore Drive reach. The City of South Bend will also need to acquire real estate interest in several privately owned parcels along this reach in order for the project to proceed. FY05 funds could be used for construction once these issues are resolved. The separate CSO #6 Section 14 project (located directly across the river from the North Shore Drive reach) is expected to be packaged with this project for construction efficiency.

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
