PROJECT: Detroit Beach, Lake Erie, Frenchtown Township, MI

DESCRIPTION: Detroit Beach, Frenchtown Township is located in Monroe County in southeastern Michigan. The purpose of the project is to investigate whether there is federal interest in assisting in repairing the existing structures providing flood control protection to Frenchtown Township.

STAGE: Feasibility

STATUS: Considerable design has been accomplished under the Advanced Measures Program that will benefit this project. The expenditures have reached the first \$100,000 that can be Federally funded without cost sharing. A Project Management Plan (PMP) and a Feasibility Cost Share Agreement (FCSA) must be developed to establish cost sharing with the Sponsor. Current information is being assembled to present to the NFS concurrently with the PMP and the FCSA. These are projected for signature in May, 2004. FY05 funds could be used to complete Feasibility, Plans & Specifications, and Construction if the sponsor remains interested.

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
