PROJECT: Genesee County, MI

DESCRIPTION: Genesee County is located in southeastern Michigan. The Genesee County Drain Commissioner (GCDC) provides sanitary sewer collection and treatment for a service area over 860 square miles, for 32 municipalities in 6 counties including Genesee, Oakland, Lapeer, Saginaw, Shiawassee and Livingston. The existing wastewater collection and treatment infrastructure has reached its planned capacity. The GCDC desires the design and construction of a rain gauge system to anticipate capacity stresses.
