



**PROJECT:** Rouge River Watershed Study, MI (Sec 212) (Dec 03)

**DESCRIPTION:** The Rouge River watershed is located in Wayne, Oakland and Macomb Counties in southeastern Michigan. The project involves evaluation of the existing watershed conditions, identification of problems and opportunities, formulation of restoration alternatives, and determination if there is a Federal interest to participate in a cost shared project in the Gateway Area.
