



PROJECT: Detroit River Environmental Dredging, MI RECON

DESCRIPTION: The study area is the Detroit River from Lake St. Clair to Lake Erie and the lower Rouge River up to the turning basin. The study is examining the environmental dredging and disposal requirements of approximately 3 million cubic yards of contaminated sediments.
