


**PROJECT FACT SHEET

PROJECT: Lansing, Michigan (Riverfront Master Plan)

DESCRIPTION: Lansing has experienced rapid development and growth along its major waterway, the Grand River. The Grand River flows through the heart of the city, and numerous bridges cross the river in the downtown area. The development of a comprehensive Master Plan of the river corridor is necessary to determine the feasibility of shoreline protection, frontal erosion, environmental restoration, and associated purposes within the downtown area of the river. A reconnaissance greenway study on the Grand River will assist in addressing these issues and improving the riverine environment.
