


PROJECT FACT SHEET (20 FEB 04)

PROJECT: Grand Haven Harbor Dredged Material Management Plan

DESCRIPTION: Grand Haven Harbor is located in western Michigan along the eastern shore of Lake Michigan in Ottawa County. A dredged material management plan study was initiated to investigate 20-year management alternatives to ensure future maintenance dredging of the harbor continues. Various alternatives are under consideration.

STAGE: Preliminary Assessment (PA)

STATUS: Community "awareness sessions" were held 16 Dec 2003 and 4 Feb 2004 for the purpose of explaining the dredged material management needs at this harbor and to identify a NFS for the Grand Haven Harbor project. Many governmental entities and leaders from throughout the area attended these sessions and much local emphasis is being placed on this important community need. Also, USACE-ERDC (formerly WES) has obtained FY04 funds to initiate a composting/recycling demonstration project to potentially create topsoil from dredged material at Grand Haven Harbor. This effort is now underway. Results from the greenhouse studies to be undertaken should be available by Summer 2004.
