

**PROJECT FACT SHEET (04 MARCH 04)**

**PROJECT:** Repairs to South Pier at Sheboygan Harbor, WI

**DESCRIPTION:** The south pier structures at Sheboygan Harbor, Wisconsin, are in need of rehabilitation due to the deterioration of existing timber pilings. The south pier structures are in a state of moderate to advanced structural deterioration as evidenced by the differential settlement and cracking of the concrete caps. This condition indicates that the timber substructures are beginning to fail in localized areas. Sedimentation is seeping and moving to the harbor side of the pier, creating a hardship for the shipping vessels traveling in the harbor. The project would consist of rehabilitating the structures to stabilize the existing structure alignment and to allow maintenance of the channel for navigation.
