PROJECT: Estral Beach, MI

DESCRIPTION: The Village of Estral Beach is located in Newport, in Monroe County, southeastern Michigan, on the western end of Lake Erie. The Village has requested a study to modify an existing Corps structure or its operation for the purposes of improving environmental quality by restoring deep water bay and navigable waterway, as well as to retard shoreline buildup along the lakeside shoreline of Estral Beach and Swan Creek Canal. The structure of interest is the existing shore protection.
