Breakwall Repairs Could Be Put On Hold

There's a chance the Petoskey breakwall may not be fixed this year due to a lack of funds. A storm in March ripped a 50-foot hole in the breakwall that protects the city's marina. The U.S. Army Corps Of Engineers say there's no money in the budget to fix it permanently. Repairs could cost anywhere from two to twelve million dollars. Engineers hoped to temporarily fix the wall with stone. That would cost under a million dollars. But all of the Corp's funds have been assigned to other projects this year.
