


PROJECT FACT SHEET

PROJECT: Harbor of Refuge, McQuade Rd, Duluth, MN

DESCRIPTION: McQuade Road project is located in St Louis County on the north shore of Lake Superior about 8 miles northeast of the Duluth Harbor entrance. The project involves the construction of two rubblemound breakwaters to create a 3.1 acre harbor of refuge.
