



PROJECT: Lower Menomonee, Milwaukee, Wisconsin Section 206 Aquatic Ecosystem Restoration Project

DESCRIPTION: The Lower Menomonee River Valley area is in the center of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, extending from the mouth of the Menomonee River where it joins the Milwaukee River, to approximately River Mile 4.0, where the river crosses Bluemound Road. The project would restore the aquatic ecosystem within this area.
