



PROJECT: Underwood Creek, Wauwatosa, Wisconsin Section 206 Aquatic Ecosystem Restoration Project

DESCRIPTION: The Underwood Creek sub-watershed is approximately 20 square miles. The mainstem of Underwood Creek is approximately eight miles long and flows easterly from its origin in the City of Brookfield to the confluence with the Menomonee River in the City of Wauwatosa. The proposed project would be 4,000 feet of ecosystem restoration along the upstream limit of Underwood Creek in the City of Wauwatosa along the western edge of the Milwaukee County Grounds.
