



PROJECT: Wilson Park Creek, Wisconsin Section 206 Aquatic Ecosystem Restoration Project

DESCRIPTION: The project would involve removing approximately 4,400 feet of the existing concrete channel lining from the South 20th Street bridge crossing (River Mile 0.87) downstream to the South 27th Street bridge crossing (River Mile 1.70) in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, for the propose of restoring the areas aquatic ecosystem habitat.
