


**PROJECT FACT SHEET**  
**February 8, 2007**

**PROJECT:** Grand River (NOWS), Grand Haven, Michigan Section 14

**DESCRIPTION:** The purpose of the project is to protect a community water transmission main that is in jeopardy of failure due to severe erosion which has occurred along the north bank of the Grand River, adjacent to the Federally maintained commercial navigation channel and just upstream of the Federally constructed and maintained pier and revetment structures. This project is physically located in the City of Grand Haven, MI, however several communities (including the Village of Spring Lake, City of Ferrysburg, City of Grand Haven, and Spring Lake Township) are involved. Each of these communities are part of the Northwest Ottawa Water System (NOWS). As such, the Ottawa County Road Commission is serving at the non-Federal project sponsor.

**STAGE:** Feasibility

**STATUS:** The PDA phase of the project (including preparation of construction plans and specifications) was completed and approved by LRD in December 2006.
