


PROJECT FACT SHEET

PROJECT: Kalamazoo River Section 1135, Battle Creek, Michigan

DESCRIPTION: Project area is on the Kalamazoo River in Battle Creek, MI. The channel was channelized by the USACE years ago for flood control and has an undesirable effect of creating a poor in-stream habitat for aquatic organisms and created a barrier to fish migration. In addition, the riparian buffer has been removed which has caused the water temperature to increase above the tolerance of some fish species. A modification to the channel improvements is requested to increase aquatic habitat.
