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Corps awards Grand Haven Pier Stimulus work to Grand Rapids company

DETROIT—The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Detroit District, recently awarded a Michigan company a \$300,819 contract, funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, to repair the pier in Grand Haven, Mich.

Construction Concepts & Design, Inc., a small business in Grand Rapids, Mich., was awarded the contract to repair 14 feet of the pier's steel sheet pile revetment wall.

The Stimulus act work also includes removing eight existing material, installing a hand railing and miscellaneous steel fabrication and installation.

The project began in July, and is expected to add about 13 direct and indirect jobs to the state.
