Corps of Engineers awards contract to Michigan firm for harbor dredging in Holland and Grand Haven

DETROIT – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Detroit District, has awarded a dredging contract for the Holland and Grand Haven harbors in western Michigan.

The \$303,800 contract was awarded to Luedtke Engineering Co. of Frankfort, Mich., which will dredge the outer harbors of both Grand Haven and Holland this spring.

Sandy shoals will be dredged from both harbors and the material will be placed on nearby beaches for nourishment.

“Ongoing maintenance of these harbors is crucial to ensuring the transport of millions of dollars worth of bulk commodities and protecting local jobs,” said Lt. Col. James Davis, district engineer.
