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Corps of Engineers awards contract to Michigan company for Holland Inner Harbor dredging project

DETROIT – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Detroit District, has awarded a \$1 million contract for dredging of the Holland Inner Harbor.

The \$1,047,650 contract was awarded to the King Company, Inc., of Holland, Mich., to dredge more than 70,000 cubic yards of shoals from the western Michigan harbor. The dredged materials will be deposited in a dredge material placement site. It is anticipated that the work will begin by early May.

“This important work will keep the Holland Harbor open to vital shipping, aiding commerce and protecting jobs,” said Lt. Col. James Davis, district engineer.
