**PROJECT:** Yellow River, Plymouth, Indiana - Section 14 (C-CAP)

**DESCRIPTION:** The Yellow River is a tributary of the Kankakee River, approximately 50 miles (80 km) long, in northern Indiana. The study area is located within the City of Plymouth, Indiana along the east bank of the Yellow River south of East LaPorte Street. In a time span of a few years, the east bank has severely eroded causing the loss of several trees on the river bank and creating an unstable situation.
