**STATUS:** The Corps and non-Federal sponsor executed a Feasibility Cost Share Agreement on 28 August 2005. Feasibility was completed in August 2010. FY11 funds will be used to execute PPA and complete Plans and Specs. This project is awaiting a millage vote in May 2011 to determine if the non-Federal sponsor will be financially capable of cost sharing. FY12 Funding would be used for construction.

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
