## PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET February 2011

**PROJECT:** Detroit River Environmental Dredging, Michigan - (I)

**DESCRIPTION:** The Detroit River flows from Lake St. Clair in a southerly direction to Lake Erie. It forms the international boundary between the United States and Canada. The Detroit River is an International Joint Commission Area of Concern (AOC). The project would review and update a previous reconnaissance report prepared for this AOC. The study is examining the environmental dredging and disposal requirements of approximately 3 million cubic yards of contaminated sediments and would evaluate the potential to use Corps authorities to conduct remedial dredging. We are requesting authority to do an expanded reconnaissance study.
