**DESCRIPTION:** A study to determine the feasibility of carrying out a project for flood damage reduction on Ore Lake and the Huron River for Hamburg and Green Oak Townships, Michigan. Project would benefit 100 plus residences in the Hamburg - Green Oak Townships. This project impacts the entire Huron River Watershed covering seven Michigan Counties of Oakland, Wayne, Livingston, Washtenaw, Ingham, Jackson, and Monroe.
