PROJECT: Kalamazoo River, Battle Creek, Michigan - Section 1135 (C-CAP)

DESCRIPTION: The project area is on the Kalamazoo River in Battle Creek, Michigan. The channel was channelized by the USACE years ago for flood control and has an undesirable effect of creating a poor in-stream habitat for aquatic organisms and created a barrier to fish migration. In addition, the riparian buffer has been removed which has caused the water temperature to increase above the tolerance of some fish species. A modification to approximately 3,760 feet of channel is requested to increase aquatic habitat.
