
PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET February 2011

PROJECT: Muskegon River Ice Jam Mitigation, Mecosta and Big Rapids Township, Mecosta County, Michigan - FPMS (I)

DESCRIPTION: The intent is to study the river hydraulics and flooding due to ice jamming the river upstream from Rogers Hydro Electric Plant through the City of Big Rapids. This will allow the county to better manage flooding issues on the Muskegon River upstream from Rogers Dam and reduce flooding impacts from ice jams.
