PROJECT: Northwestern Michigan College, Great Lakes Maritime Academy, Traverse City, Michigan - Section 107 (C-CAP)

DESCRIPTION: The project is located at the Great Lakes Maritime Academy Harbor on the Northwestern Michigan College campus in Traverse City, MI along the southern shore of the west arm of Grand Traverse Bay. Renovations to the northern, western, and southern walls of the harbor have been completed by the College. The NFS requested USACE assistance to reconfigure the eastern arm of the harbor to provide a protected berth for vessels and to reduce the amount of shoaling and subsequent dredging currently required.

STAGE: Feasibility

STATUS: The Feasibility Cost Sharing Agreement (FCSA) was executed in September 2008. The cost-shared feasibility phase is currently underway. The Agency Technical Review (ATR) and Great Lakes and Ohio River Division reviews will be completed in FY2011, followed by preparation of detailed plans and specifications and construction contract award in FY 2011.

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
