**PROJECT:** Oakland County, Michigan - Section 219 (C)

**DESCRIPTION:** Oakland County is located in southeastern Michigan and includes a northern portion of the Detroit metropolitan area. This project implements the George W. Kuhn Combined Sewer Overflow Program, which includes numerous improvements to the existing system. The entire George W. Kuhn Drainage Improvement Project will be implemented through multiple construction contracts with a total cost of approximately \$144 million. The USACE has received a \$20,000,000 authority to assist with infrastructure improvements.
