PROJECT: Ontonagon Harbor, Michigan - Section 111 (C-CAP)

DESCRIPTION: A study of shore damage in the vicinity of the Ontonagon Harbor project to determine if the damage is the result of a Federal navigation project. If so determined, Corps would carry out a project to mitigate the damage under Section 111 of the River and Harbor Act of 1968. The locals have indicated that the East Pier Walkway is presently unusable and has become a safety hazard due to the damage that has occurred to the walkway and the underlying stone structure. The restoration of the walkway would allow use to resume and would improve safety.
