**PROJECT:** Port Sanilac, Michigan - Section 111 (C-CAP)

**DESCRIPTION:** Port Sanilac Harbor is located in Eastern Michigan on Lake Huron. The project is being investigated for possible mitigation of damages to the outlying shoreline due to the federal navigation project.

**STAGE:** Feasibility

**STATUS:** The hydrology and hydraulics of the harbor was investigated to determine if the damages incurred are due to the Federal project. The study resulted in no change to the current plan. A more detailed investigation would be required to further evaluate the conditions. However this would require non-Federal cost sharing. No additional work will be done at the harbor under the Section 111 Authority. This project has been terminated.

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
