**DESCRIPTION:** Sault Ste Marie, Michigan Construction of a large, Poe-sized (110' by 1200') replacement lock on the site of the existing Davis and Sabin Locks to provide for more efficient movement of waterborne commerce.

**STATUS:** The coffer dam contract for the main chamber (\$2M) is complete as well as the down stream approach channel excavation (\$7M). Work on design, plans and specifications continues for the lock chamber, channel deepening and approach guide walls. Plans and specifications will be completed as funds become available. Additional contracting will be awarded as funds are provided without committing the Federal Government to future appropriations.
