PROJECT: Rouge River Supplemental Watershed Management Plan, Michigan - (I)

DESCRIPTION: The Rouge River watershed is located in Wayne, Oakland and Washtenaw Counties in southeastern Michigan. The study area encompasses 48 communities and portions of 3 counties of southeast Michigan. The Rouge River Watershed Management Study area is the most downstream 8 miles of the river to its confluence with the Detroit River in Wayne County, MI. A reconnaissance study was approved on 3 June 2004 and recommended evaluation of problems related to fish passage, streambank stabilization, oxbow and habitat restoration, and stormwater treatment thru wetland restoration.

STAGE: Feasibility

STATUS: The Alliance of Rouge Communities (ARC) has expressed interest in being the local non-Federal project sponsor. The ARC needs to identify a project that they would want to study in the Feasibility Phase by entering into a cost-shared study with the USACE, Detroit District. Upon selection of a project by the ARC, a Project Management Plan and Feasibility Cost Share Agreement will be completed by the USACE. This project has been combined with the Rouge River Watershed (Gateway Area) project.

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
