

PROJECT: Rouge River Watershed (Gateway Area), Michigan - (I)

DESCRIPTION: The Rouge River Watershed Gateway Area is downstream of the Rouge River Watershed Management Study area and the most downstream 8 miles of the river to its confluence with the Detroit River in Wayne County, MI. A reconnaissance study was approved on 3 June 2004 and recommended evaluation of problems related to fish passage, streambank stabilization, oxbow and habitat restoration, and stormwater treatment through wetland restoration.
